1.2. Platform Agnostic News & Sports Entries

The Academy to treat all News & Sports programs as platform agnostic. For example, entering a sports host on a digital web-only sports show will no longer be required to enter digital media categories, and will be eligible to enter sports categories in the television stream of the awards.

2. RULE OF FOUR

Rule of Four (News & Sports Categories Only)

If fewer than four Entries are received in a single Category, the decision to award the Category is left at the discretion of the Academy. In this situation, the Category may be collapsed into another Category. Previously, News & Sports categories were subject to Rule of Six, which now only applies to non-sports and non-news categories.
