IMAGE SUBMISSION TIPS & NOTES

IMAGE ORIENTATION TYPES*



Our website automatically crops the images submitted to the dimensions listed on page 1, cropping from the centre of the photo. We recommend submitting a Portrait image, as they are more likely to remain in tact during the cropping process. Submission of a landscape photo will result in a majority of the photo cropped out, as illustrated below.

CENTRE HEADSHOT SUBJECT*

It is imperative that headshots are submitted at the correct dimensions. Those that are not run the risk of being cut off, as illustrated below.

Please ensure that the subject(s)' head is centred within the frame with negative space surrounding.
